Managers or staff/specialists who are involved in logistics or logistics management in their company/industrial promotion association in ASEAN 10 countries.

Language

All lectures and observation tours are provided in English or accompanied by an English interpreter.

Participation Fee (incl. Accommodation, Meals, Program Implementation Cost, etc.)

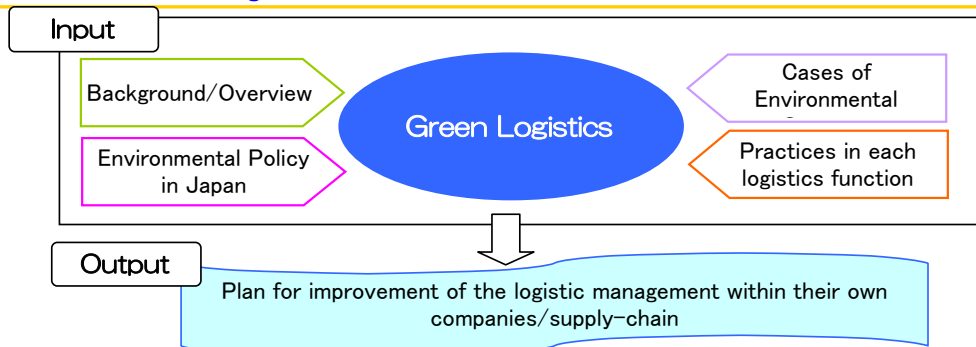
